<i>Priest's introduction</i>	Brothers and sisters, Jesus gave us a new commandment: love one another. By this commandment everyone will know that we are his disciples.
<i>Intention 1</i>	<b>Let us pray for Christians throughout the world, that we will love one another and bring peace to the world.</b> <i>Pause</i> <b>Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.</b>
<i>Intention 2</i>	<b>Let us pray for Pope Francis's Prayer Intention that young people, called to live life to the fullest, will see in Mary's life the way to listen, the courage that faith generates, and the dedication to service.</b> <i>Pause</i> <b>Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.</b>
<i>Intention 3</i>	<b>Let us pray for those who govern the nations that they may rule with integrity and justice so that all may live in peace</b> <i>Pause</i> <b>Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.</b>
<i>Intention 4</i>	<b>Let us pray for those who are burdened by worry or illness that they will receive comfort in their time of need</b> <i>Pause</i> <b>Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.</b>
	<i>If the celebrant wishes, an extra, last-minute intention may be added here by hand before Mass.</i>
<i>Intention 5</i>	<b>Let us pray for those who have died, may they enter in joy into the Lord's kingdom.</b> <i>Pause</i> <b>Lord, in your mercy. Hear our prayer.</b>
	<b>Let us ask Our Lady to join her prayers with ours as we say: Hail Mary...</b>
