

Our main event each year is to join dioceses throughout England and Wales for the annual pilgrimage to Walsingham. I would like to share with you the excellent homily given by John Arnold, Bishop of Salford, whose turn it was to lead our pilgrimage a few weeks ago.

Bishop John began by saying he had been asked to preach on 'joy'. Not an easy subject for today because although we have many joys on the local level, he said the world presents a different picture. In recent years we have been going through a period of great darkness and intense suffering on a huge scale: covid with its long term mental effects; Ukraine, a senseless war, with its horrific suffering and vast numbers of refugees; climate change with its devastating effects on poorer countries; and meanwhile millions go hungry while the gap between rich and poor continues to increase. There is little grounds for joy here!

However, Bishop John went on to draw our attention to two very hopeful signs: firstly, the way young people, especially in our schools, are responding to global warming and the need to cherish the environment. And secondly, Pope Francis himself; his inspirational leadership and the vision of a global family which he presents to the world.

The Bishop concluded by reminding us of our call to be a people of hope and joy, pointing out however, that for Christians, our joy is to found elsewhere. When we look towards Mary we find no stranger to suffering: her anguish of losing her child Jesus for three days; her growing concern as she watched the mounting hostility directed towards him and yet she was able to radiate serenity and joy because her life was founded on deep trust in God. With Mary's help and in spite of the dark times in which we live, we too can find that joy, to be shared with others.
