www.saintsofsussex.com/church-and-hallavailability It's sometimes a delicate thing to approach as a priest when visiting the sick. It's also one of the most powerful experiences. At the coronation of our king, Charles III, last May, we saw him receive it, leading many people in our secular age to ask what it was all about. Even many of the avowedly irreligious admitted to finding it moving. That's the movement of the spirit, prodding restless hearts to find rest in faith! What am I talking about? Anointing. It is the Sacrament of God's healing love, and the three oils are the oil of the sick, the oil of baptism, and the oil of chrism, used at the Sacraments of Confirmation and Ordination. You have to be delicate as a priest because, in a previous age, the oil of the sick or infirmorum was used for a ritual called Extreme Unction, received at the time of death. Indeed, priests can still have the experience of broaching the topic, and the response being, 'Am I dying?' It needs to be presented with the language of love and kindness. Modern theology commends it to those who are infirm in mind, body, and spirit or feel the advance of years. The Bible is replete with examples of the anointing of priests, prophets and kings, which was the symbolism and the auspices under which King Charles received it. This language enters the rituals of the aforementioned Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Ordination. We anoint hearts, heads and hands and so pray for and bring love, wisdom, healing and blessing. These are good sentiments to meditate on as we mark the World Day of Prayer for the Sick, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, and prepare to begin Lent next Wednesday. On Spy Wednesday evening, March 27th, at Arundel, at the Chrism Mass, Bishop Richard will bless the oils to be used throughout the diocese for the year ahead. It's a powerful symbol of unity with our diocese and the universal church. It would be great to see a good representation of our community. Also, speaking of the Sacrament of the Sick, it will take place in Bosham on Thursday, March 21st, as part of the monthly Event organized by our Parish Visitation and Support Group. The sacrament will be given within Mass, beginning at 12:15. Please let the parish office know if you would like to attend. Finally, speaking of our king, we pray for his healing and comfort as he begins his cancer treatment.
