John's Gospel account of the resurrection begins with Mary Magdalen arriving alone at the tomb. Upon seeing the stone removed, she fled to Peter and the other disciple whom Jesus loved. They ran, looked inside the tomb, and realized from the carful placement of the cloths that there had been no robbery. Coming out of the tomb they began to believe, but, as John tells us, they had not yet understood the meaning of the scriptures, they returned home. In the light of the risen appearances of the Lord, they realized what God has done in Jesus, for them and the whole world.

Through baptism into the church we take on the mantle of the apostolic witnesses. That is why we still gather early in the morning on the first day of every week to celebrate this feast of the empty tomb, give thanks for "Christ our life," as today's Epistle calls Him. Baptized into His death and Resurrection, we live the heavenly life of the risen Christ, our lives "hidden with Christ in God." We are now His witnesses, too. But we testify to things we cannot see but only believe; we seek in earthly things what is above. We live in memory of the Apostles' witness, like them eating and drinking with the risen Lord at the altar. And we wait in hope for what the Apostles told us would come - the day when we too "will appear with Him in glory."
