with regard to vocations. This is my theory, which I am sure is not original, let me explain:

As we grow in understanding that we are a missionary church, Christ's faithful will inevitably become more involved in the running of their parishes and more generous in sharing their gifts and time in building up the local community. A direct result of this will be to 'free up' our priests to do what they have been ordained to do: To proclaim the Gospel, celebrate mass, offer the sacraments, visit the sick and truly become the shepherds they are called to be. With less administrative worries and workload they will be able to carry out their priestly duties with a 'lighter step', with more energy, freedom and joy.

As our young people observe this, they will be more attracted to the church, and with the help of our prayers and encouragement some of them might seriously consider a vocation to the priesthood or religious life.

There is nothing novel in this theory. We all know what impact witness can have on others. May I hasten to add, much of what is being proposed is already happening in our own parish. Without doubt we are in a very strong position to embrace our Diocesan Pastoral Plan. Let us do so, therefore, with confidence and a growing sense of mission, knowing that one of the fruits will surely be an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life

May God continue to bless us all in this joyful season of Eastertide.
